If you send your application late or without confirmation of payment or without double-sided legible copy of pedigree or without the name of owner in pedigree your application will not be accepted!!!

The date of payment influences inclusion of payments the 1st or 2nd entry deadline. Pay the fee for 2 or more dogs together. Classification to class depends on the age of dog on the day of show. Division into classes is governed by Show Regulation of the Bohemian and Moravian Cynological Union (ČMKU). For inclusion in the working class, please provide a certificate of completion of an examination. Entry form to the champion class must be accompanied by a copy of the obtained title (championship, national winner, club winner or special show winner). Listed titles must be obtained in competition with adults. If the dog has a birthday on the day of show, exhibitor can choose the class.

Handling fee: Cancellation of application form till the second entry deadline is 100 CZK. After the second entry deadline it is not possible to cancel. You must pay 100 CZK, if you want to replace your dog in another class. It is not possible to do it after the second entry deadline.

Classes:

Minor puppy	4 - 6 months
Puppy	6 - 9 months
Junior (CAJC)	9 - 18 months
Intermediate (CAC)	15 - 24 months
Open (CAC)	15 months and over
Working (CAC)	15 months and over (FCI working certificate compulsory)
Winner (CAC)	15 months and over (enclose some of these certificates: National Winner, Club Winner, Special Show Winner, European Winner, World Winner, Champion CR, Champion ČMKU, C.I.B, C.I.E., Champion from any states FCI)
Veteran	8 years and over
Honorary	15 months and over (enclose some of these certificates: National Winner, Club Winner, Special Show Winner, European Winner, World Winner, Champion CR, Champion ČMKU, C.I.B, C.I.E., Champion from any states FCI). In this class we don't give CAC. Excellent 1 doesn't participate in the Special Winner competition, but it proceeds in the contest of BOB or BOS.

In each class we evaluate the first four dogs with a grade very promising or promising and excellent or very good.

Titles, challenge certificates and competitions:

CAJC CR- certificate for the Czech Junior champion can get a male and female with Excellent 1 in junior class.

CAC CR- certificate for the Czech champion can get a male and female with Excellent 1 in intermediate, open, working and winner class.

CAC Reserve - can get a male and female with excellent 2 in intermediate, open, working and winner class, if in the class was given CAC.

BOJ – The best junior. There could be dogs with CAJC.

BOV – The best of veterans. There could be male and female with Excellent 1 from class Veterans.

BOB – Best of breed. Given to one out of titles Junior Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl, Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl, Veteran Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl and excellent 1 from honorary class.

BOS - the best individual of the opposite sex. Given to one out of titles Junior Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl, Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl, Veteran Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl and excellent 1 from honorary class of the opposite sex as BOB.

Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl - awarded separately male and female. Given to one out of CAC in intermediate, open, working and winner class.

Junior Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl - awarded separately male and female, who won the title CAJC.

Veteran Winner of Memorial of Karel Hartl - awarded separately male and female, who was excellent 1 in veteran class.

ČKŠ – *Waiting of Club champion* – can get a dog on the show organized by KCHČSV, who got in the classes CAC – Excellent 1 – CAC and whose owner is the member KCHČSV during the show. If the owner of the dog with Excellent 1 isn't the club member, the second dog with Excellent 2, res. CAC and whose owner is the member KCHČSV receives ČKŠ. If CAC receives a dog who is Club Champion, ČKŠ gets dog with Ex2, res. CAC and whose owner is the member KCHČSV.

The best minnor puppy – a male and female participate in the competition, who were very promising 1 in the minnor puppy class.

The best puppy – a male and female participate in the competition, who were very promising 1 in the puppy class.

Best brace – dog and bitch of the same breed owned by the same owner, who was at the show assessed.

Best breeders group - for at least 3 dogs of the same breeder and max 5 dogs, which were assessed at the show, coming from one breeder and a minimum of two fathers or mothers. They may not be in the same ownership.

Documents necessary for the participation in the show:

FCI dog's pedigree or in the class minnor puppy and puppy confirmation of breeding book, that the pedigree will be issued. Pet passport with proof of rabies vaccination. Club member card (if the owner is member of KCHČSV CR or SR). Club member card with member mark or payment confirmation.

Veterinary conditions:

Dogs must be clinically healthy. Dogs must be equipped with a pet passport or a vaccination record and must have valid anthrax vaccination in accordance with § 4 part 1 letter f) of veterinary act must show the proof of immunity against distemper, parvovirus and leptospirosis. Dogs from EU member states and third countries must have the pet passport and fulfil the conditions of the Regulation 998/2003 of May 26, 2003. Sick dogs, dogs suspected to be sick, dogs after an injury, bitches in season, bitches in second half of gravidity, nursing bitches shall not be admitted at the show.

General Conditions:

A competition organizer isn't responsible for damage caused by dogs or exhibitor, even for dead or loss of dog. Free running of dogs in the whole exhibition site isn't allowed. Owners must guarantee their dogs not to attack each other or hurt some person. We recommend muzzles.

The dogs that are not listed in the catalogue are excluded. Exception: exhibitor's dogs which are not listed by exhibitor's guilt or dogs that are to be included in the Auxiliary register.

Also those dogs are disqualified: Ill dogs. Suspicious of illness. After hurt. Docked dogs. Dogs that owner haven't any right to display. Dangerous dogs – biting, aggressive to other people or dogs. Female in season. Female in second half of gravidity. Lactating females.

Exhibitors are responsible for happiness of dogs. It is prohibited some situation which can cause some damage of dog, e. g. To let dog in the car in very hot or freezing weather or behave rudely to a dog. In these cases owners and dogs will be excluded.

It is prohibited to modify the skin, to edit snout by anything that changes the structure, colour or shape. You can groom the dog only by combing and brushing (any substance or device is prohibited).

Exhibitors must keep Exhibitor rules FCI and ČMKU. They confirm it by handing on application.

Exhibitors must keep order in the whole exhibition site. All fees will be used for payment for costs of exhibition in the case that the exhibition will not be held from force majeure. It is prohibited to show puppies for selling. Changes of judges are reserved. A random chip check can be done during exhibition.

Complaints:

Objections against any decisions made by a judge shall not be permissible. However, formal complaints concerning violation of show rules and provisions may be filed. Such complaint must be submitted in written form along with a principal of 1500 CZK and only within the show (till the end of judging). If the complaint isn't denied, the principal forfeits to the organizer of the show.
